

City of Jackson Public Hearing Notice

To all interested citizens of Jackson, Kentucky:

The Kentucky Department for Local Government is accepting application material under the 2024 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG-DR) Program. The City of Jackson in Breathitt County, Kentucky, proposes to enhance its capacity to 2.5 million gallons per day (MGD). This project is essential to address the aging infrastructure and resilience against extreme weather events, such as the significant flooding experienced in 2022.

Comments on Application

A copy of the CDBG-DR application material will be on file at the Jackson City Hall for citizens' review and comment during regular business hours from January 21, 2025 through January 28, 2024. Comments on the proposed application may be submitted to the attention of Mayor Laura Thomas until the close of business on January 28, 2025.
